HOW TO CERTIFY YOUR DOCUMENTS

A certified copy is a document that has been certified as a true copy of an original document.

To certify a document, take the original document and a photocopy to one of the people listed in the categories below and ask them to certify that the photocopy is a true and correct copy of the original document. That person will need to print their name, date and the capacity in which they are signing (e.g. postal agent, Justice of the Peace).

Sample wording is as follows:

I, [full name], as [category of persons as listed below], certify that this [name of document] is a true and correct copy of the original [signature and date].

Who Can Certify Copies Of Identification (ID) Documents?

Legal	 □ solicitor or barrister (that is, a person who is enrolled on the roll of the Supreme Court of a State or □ Territory, or the High Court of Australia, as a legal practitioner (however described)); □ a judge of a court; □ a magistrate; □ a chief executive officer of a Commonwealth court; □ a registrar or deputy registrar of a court; □ a notary public
JP	a Justice of the Peace
Police	a police officer
Chartered Accountant	a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia, Certified Practising Accountants Australia or the National Institute of Accountants with 2 or more years of continuous membership
Post Office	an agent of the Australian Postal Corporation who is in charge of an office supplying postal services to the public
	 a permanent employee of the Australian Postal Corporation with 2 or more years of continuous service who is employed in an office supplying postal services to the public
Diplomatic service	an Australian consular officer
	an Australian diplomatic officer (within the meaning of the Consular Fees Act 1985)
Financial corporations (Bank, Building Society,	 an officer with 2 or more continuous years of service with one or more financial institutions (for the purposes of the Statutory Declaration Regulations 1993);
Credit Union)	 a finance company officer with 2 or more continuous years of service with one or more finance companies (for the purposes of the Statutory Declaration Regulations 1993);
	an officer with, or authorised representative of, a holder of an Australian financial services license, having 2 or more continuous years of service with one or more licensees.
